>> Clear Hoop Pine



Hoop Pine, (*Arucaria cunninghamii*) is a traditional native Australian species grown predominantly in Queensland. The species has been successfully grown in plantations offering sustainability and continuity of supply whilst also being accredited (ISO14001) to meet acceptable environmental standards.

Hoop pine is highly sought after by a variety of industries and manufacturers for the following reasons:

Even grain and texture making it easier to machine, turn or mould to a smooth finish

Has a consistently uniform colour making it easier to match when joining

Stains consistently and evenly to provide a high quality finish. It's light colour allows it to accept a wider colour range of stains

Less resinous than other Pine species whilst remaining extremely easy to glue, screw and nail.

Whilst Hoop Pine is available in a array of grades, our mouldings are produced from Number 1 Clears. This is the premium grade, and each piece of Number 1 Clears is completely clear of defects on all sides except for the occasional surface blemish which is removed in the machining process.
