>> Finger Jointed Pine



Finger jointing pine is a process developed to utilize offcuts, shorter pieces and lower grade material. Clear dockings are machined and joined together using micro joints bonded with cross linked PVA glue. Lengths of Finger Jointed Pine are generally produced to set lengths of 5.4 m for production of our vast range of Moulding Profiles.

Larger volumes of other set length Finger Jointed components can be produced specifically to the individual customers needs by arrangement.

Finger jointing is valuable as part of an overall strategy for efficient use of the worlds pine plantations. The end user benefits with less waste, greater stability and superior clear finish of the products produced. Finger Jointed Material is usually unsuitable for clear finished purposes and more suited to applications where a painted finish is to be applied.
